1	James offered tons of different ways to learn the material. He constantly had different activities we did in class rather than just reading the ppt. I think it made comprehension a lot easier.
2	James has done an excellent job teaching this class. Prior to taking this course, I was in between majors with no clear idea of what I wanted to pursue. After taking this class, I can say that this course has made me realize how much I enjoy language on a technical level to the point that I have decided to leave my engineering school to join the College of Liberal Arts to pursue a degree in linguistics. Aside from having intimate knowledge regarding linguistics, and making that knowledge easily accessible to students, James goes above and beyond by providing class activities and room for class discussions on relevant topics. In general, James is a warm and approachable person who seems to enjoy his field of study and is eager to share it with others who may find it interesting as well. In my experience, this makes for the best kind of mentor.
3	James did a wonderful job of covering a LOT of material very effectively. He had a difficult task in condensing the entire field of linguistics down into an overview class, but he did so extremely well. His presentations were well-made, and the examples were extremely helpful in understanding the material. He was also extremely effective at engaging the class, and encouraging us to share our own experiences with one another.
4	I really liked learning about the material during lecture and then reading it in the book. The information was a lot easier to understand this way.
5	I love this class. The class material is presented in an interesting and engaging way and the expectations of the class are reasonable and achievable.
6	I have never seen an instructor in a college course use so many interactive activities and put so much work into them. All of my classes are around the same size of this one, but I barely see teachers that make such an effort to create activities such as their own linguistics chutes and ladders or bingo or old maid. The activities obviously involved lots of thought and required sitting down and creating them. The teacher went above and beyond expectations with making activities and study help for the students.
7	He was always well-prepared with his lesson plan, was able to answer most questions, and gave appropriate quizzes and homeworks.
8	He often took a lot of his own time to create well-made, thought out games and puzzles and worksheets for us to use when reviewing, which really did help us and clearly took a lot of his own time and materials. I often referred back to the worksheets we did in class when studying for quizzes or doing homework. I'm glad we had fewer homework assignments because a lot of what we learned was put down on paper in class. He drew from the languages a lot of us in the class knew and consulted us to explain some of the other examples of new course material that may be applicable to the second language we speak, which made us feel involved and helped us apply the course to our other language.
